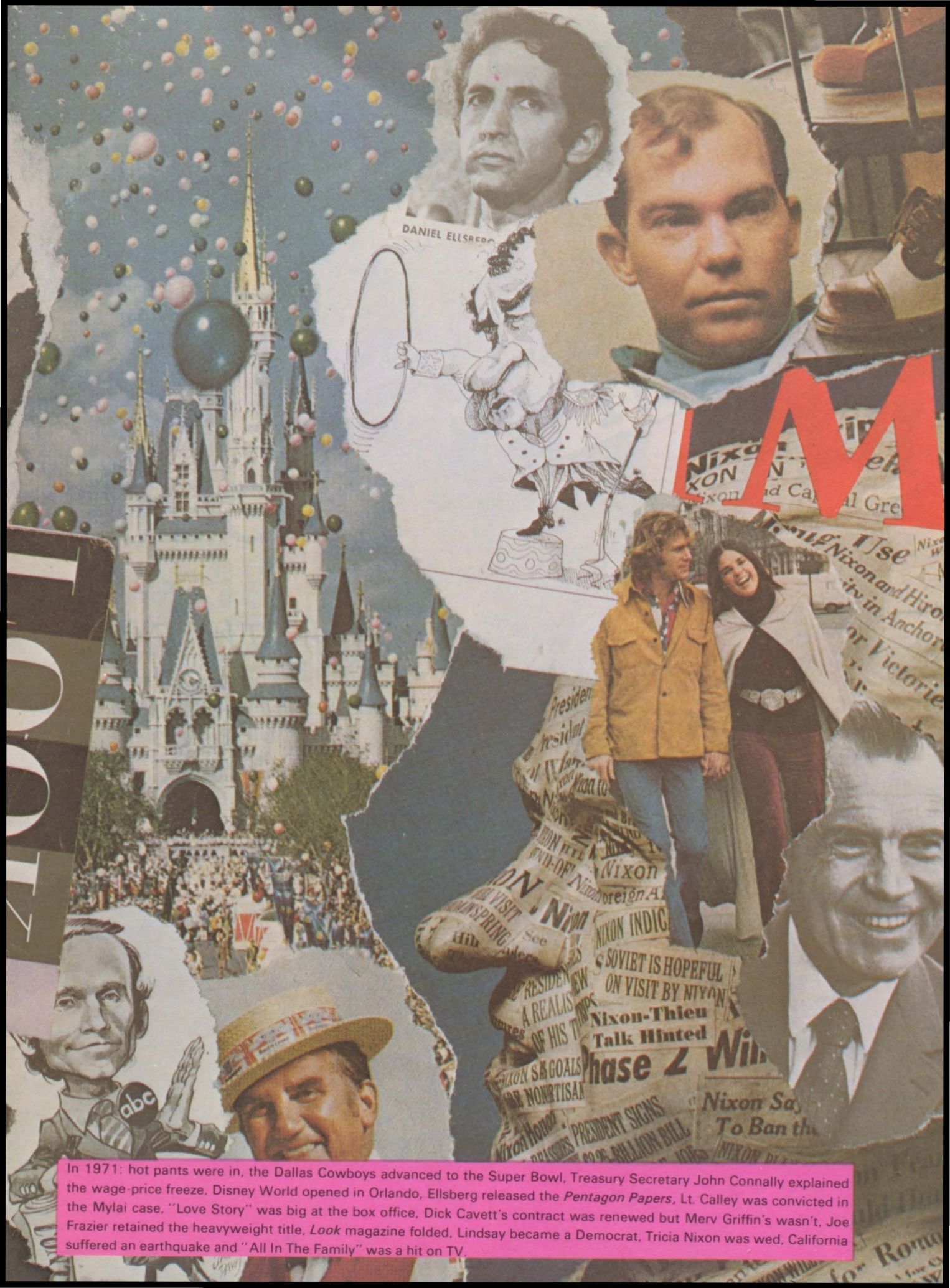

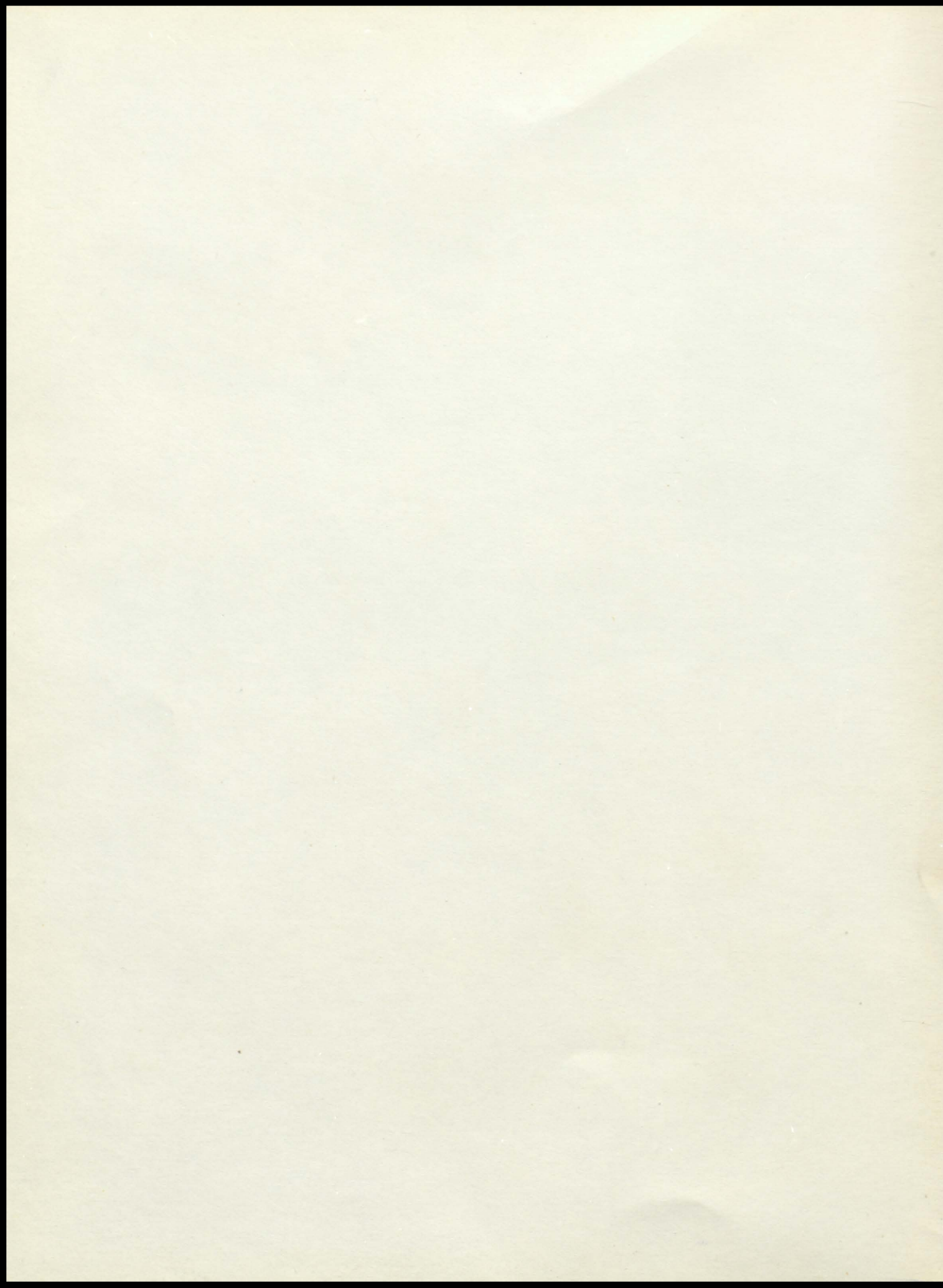

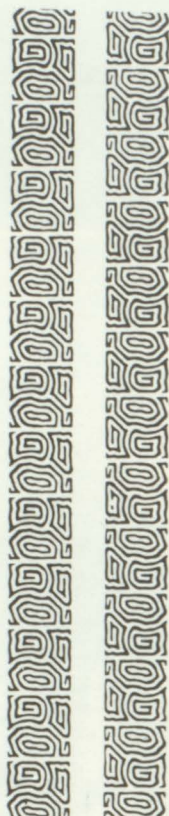

The following poem was a favorite of Miss Condiff's.

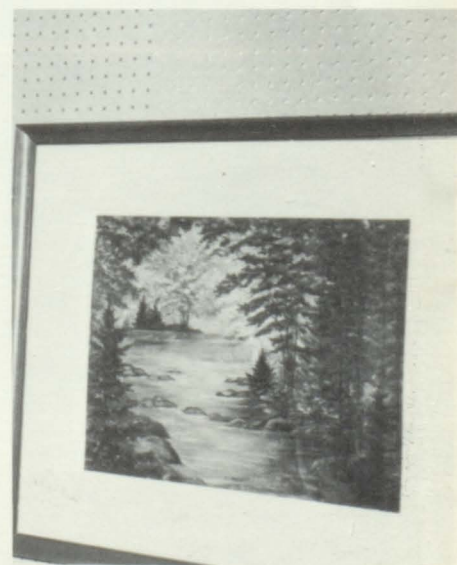
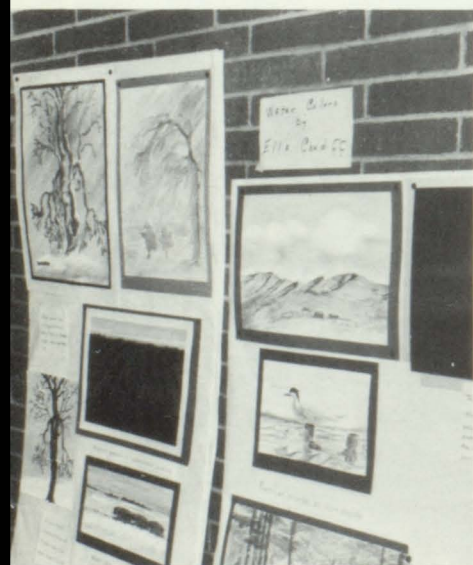
