

The Climax Chapter was very busy with many activities throughout the year. Kit Schwartzman, Cary Bernhardson, Melanie Bruun, Eric Thoreson, and Brian Chandler attended the National FFA Convention in Kansas City. They brought back a lot of useful information.

The Chapter was 51 members strong this year, 11 of these were Greenhands. These Greenhands contributed

a lot to the organization.

At the Chapter Banquet 14 Chapter Proficiency awards were given out in 8 different areas of agriculture. Karen Howsen and Larry Johnson were inducted as Honorary Chapter Farmers. Judging awards and other

various Chapter awards were handed out.

Strong Chapter projects such as the Annual Fishing Trip and Softball Tourny help to maintain interest throughout the summer. Summer test plots were introduced this year to the Horticulture students.

Doing things with other chapters has helped them to carry out larger projects, one of these is the Children's Barnyard. The Crookston FFA helps them to put this on each year at the Red River Valley Winter Shows.

All of these activities have helped to strengthen the Chapter and teach new things to the members.

The FHA's main goal this year was to promote school spirit. We painted a Viking on the gym wall, supported the teams, and put on an Athletic Banquet in the spring.


Lori, Linda, and Pam went to the State Convention with two Action Activity Events. Lori also ran for State office.

We've had great experiences and it has been a rewarding year.



Following the Banquet "Patchwork" provided the music for dancing which lasted till midnight.








The Girls Track Team Made And

At the high school level they offer such classes as Food Services, Con. Trades, Welding, Auto Body Repair, Ag. Occupations, and Power Mechanics to name a few.


It also extends beyond high school with such classes for adults as Adult and Veteran Farm Manag, and special courses.
