7. **HURRICANE CAMILLE** — Five persons await rescue on rail tracks between Gulfport and New Orleans after winds had lifted their house.

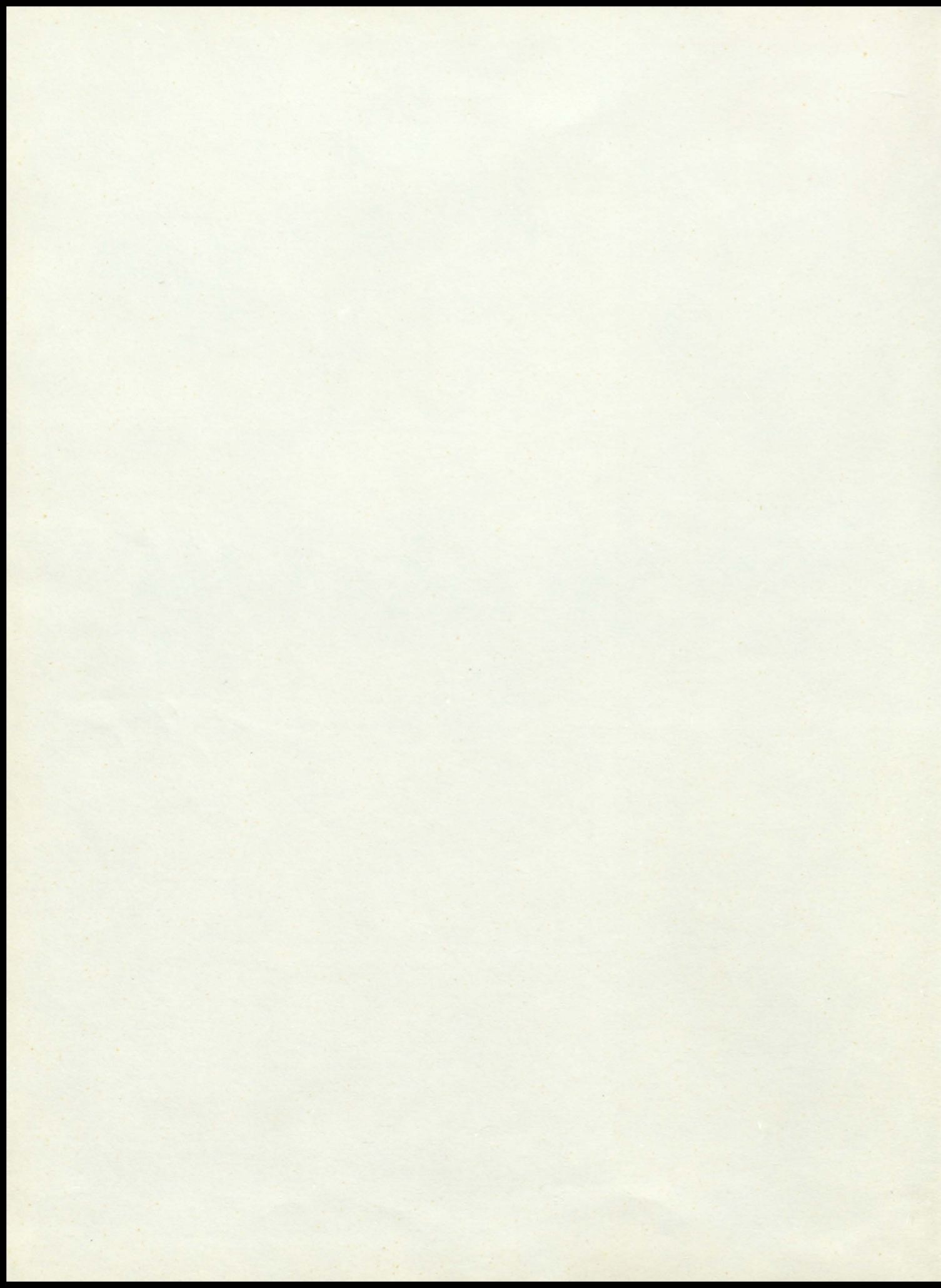

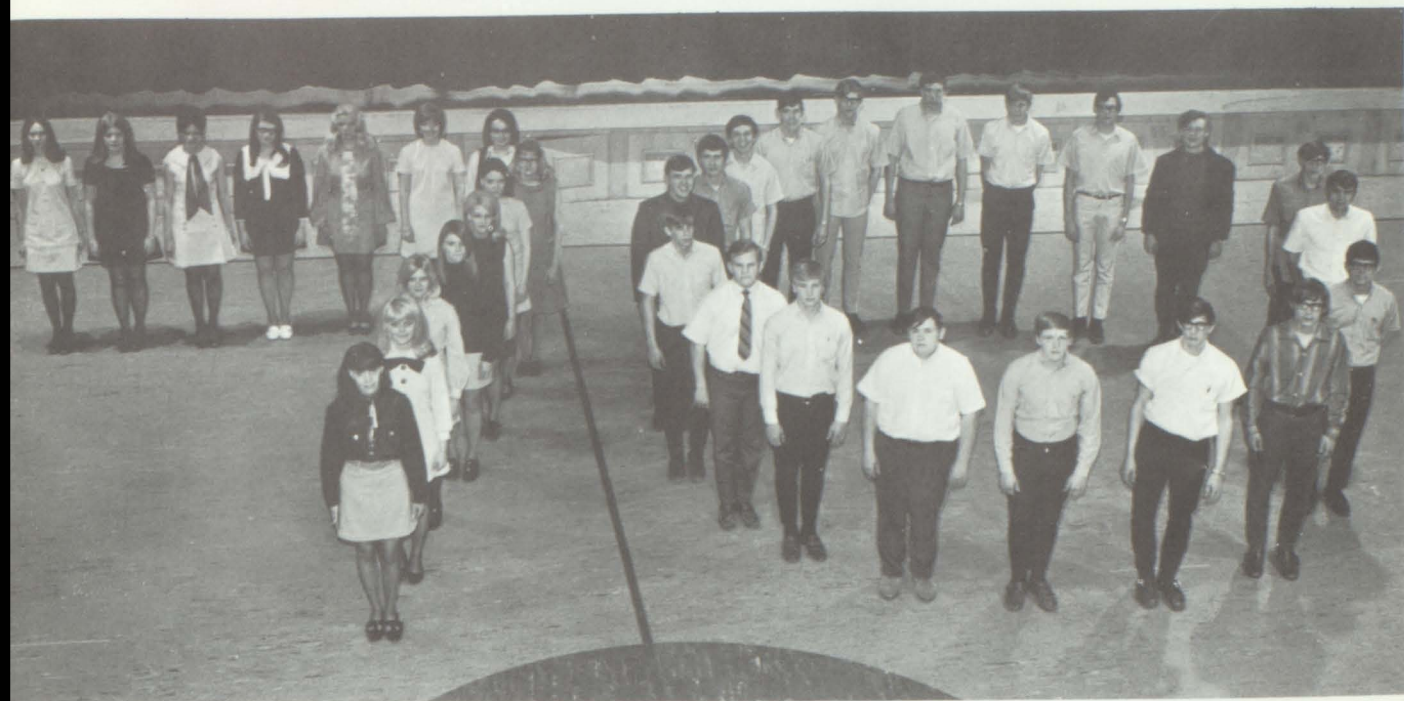

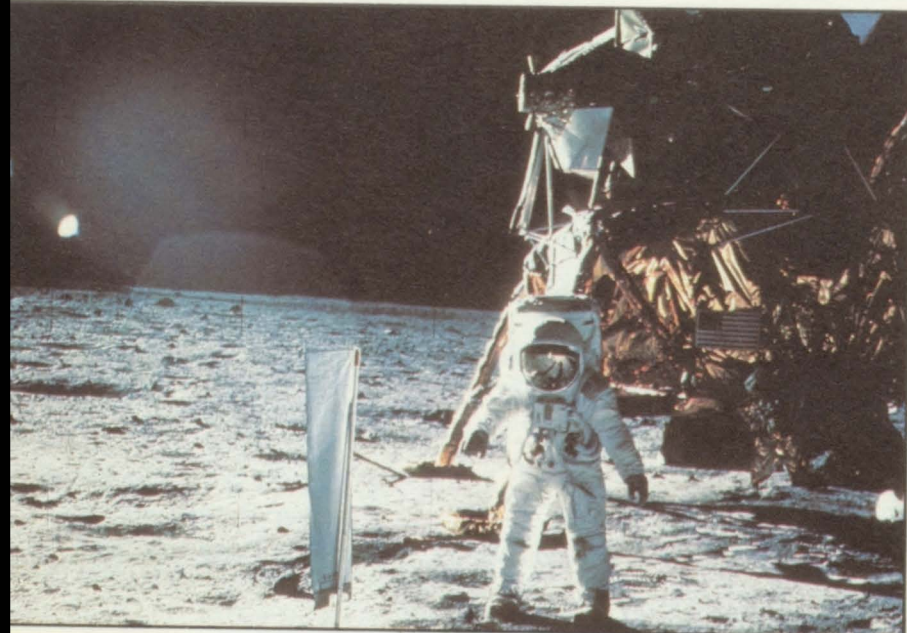
