





The Marcus Aas Memorial Trophy pictured above, will be engraved each year with the name of a student selected by the faculty who they feel has exhibited the best all around school spirit.

















## JULIE SORENSON CROWNED AS '74 HOMECOMING QUEEN









This year the Science Club grew from 21 members to a mighty group of 63. They took field trips to Houske Funeral Home, the Moorhead State College Planatarium, and sent three delegates to the Science Symposium in St. Paul. Elaine Ramstad and Bryan Stortroen were elected regional delegates to the Minnesota Junior Academy of Science.

The Science Club put on their Fourth Annual Science Fair this year. The fair included 110 projects and several movies were shown. Eight exhibitors proceeded on to the regional fair and received exceptional ratings.

Representing the school at the state level were Bryan and Elaine. Bryan received a red ribbon and honorable mention certificate for his project dealing with Solar Energy. He also received certificates from the Army and Air Force, a \$25 bond from the Corrosive Engineers Association, and a trip to exhibit his project at Northern States Power. Elaine received a blue ribbon and second place in the Senior High Biology division for her project entitled "The Effects of Carbon Monoxide on the Coronary Arteries.
