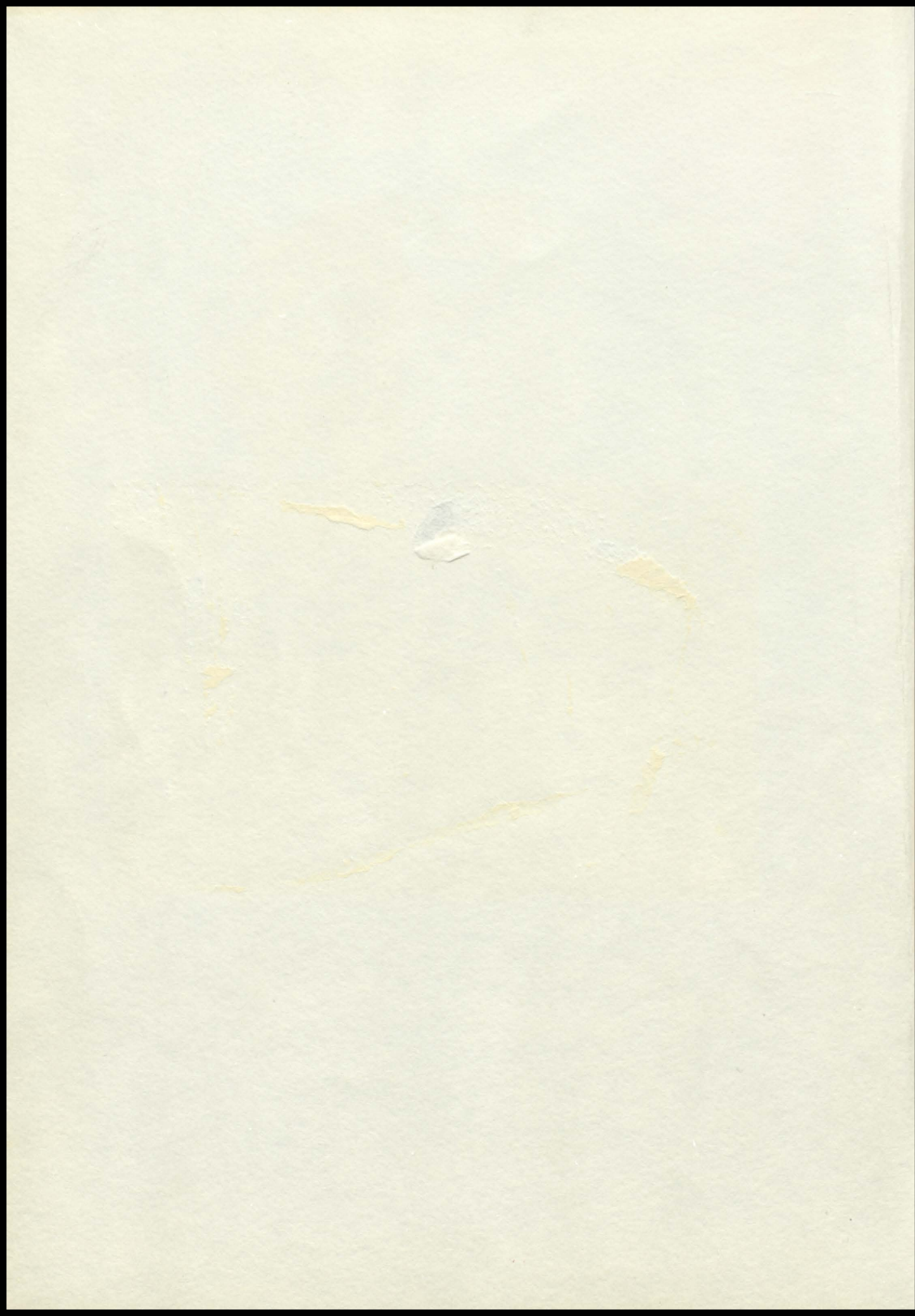

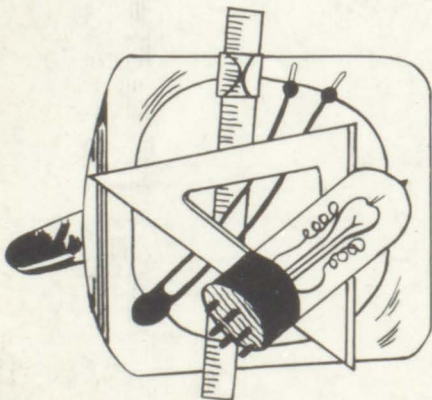


# DEDICATION

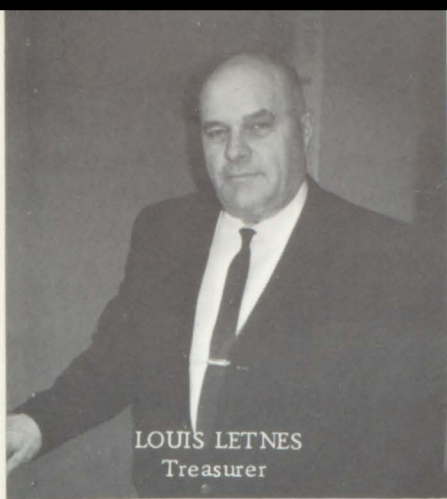
